

## Configure Mac OS X 10.7 (Lion) & Mac OS X 10.8 (Mountain Lion) for Wireless PittNet

### Overview

The University of Pittsburgh's Wireless PittNet service provides wireless network access to all University of Pittsburgh students, faculty, and staff. In Mac OS X 10.7 (Lion), it is even easier than in previous versions to connect to Wireless PittNet.

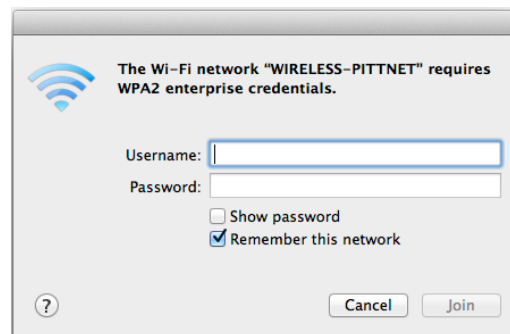
Note: You must have installed the InCommon certificates before completing the instructions below. Refer to the help sheet titled [Installing the InCommon and UserTrust Certificates \(Mac\)](#) for details.

### Connecting to Wireless PittNet with Mac OS X 10.7 & Mac OS X 10.8

1. Click **AirPort status** menu in the top right-hand corner of the screen and select **WIRELESS-PITNET**.



2. Enter your University Computing Account username and password and click **Join**.



3. Your computer will be connected to Wireless PittNet when the **AirPort status** icon changes from gray to black.
4. Verify the connection by opening a new Web page in your browser.

**Note:** When you put the computer to sleep, log out, or restart, it should automatically reconnect to Wireless PittNet when you return to the desktop.
